Whose fault is it? The children? The parents? I'm sure we could easily argue both are contributors. However, many kids have never been taught good manners. Perhaps it's because kids rarely sit around the table with their family. Here is a list of some basic table manners to teach your kids...and spouse!

- *No elbows on the table
- *Place your napkin on your lap
- *Wipe your mouth with your napkin, not on your hands or sleeve
- *Chew your food with your mouth closed
- *Say "please" when asking and "thank you" when it's received
- *Do not talk with your mouth full
- *Do not tip back your chair
- *Place your utensils on your plate between bites
- *When finished, ask to be excused before leaving the table
